



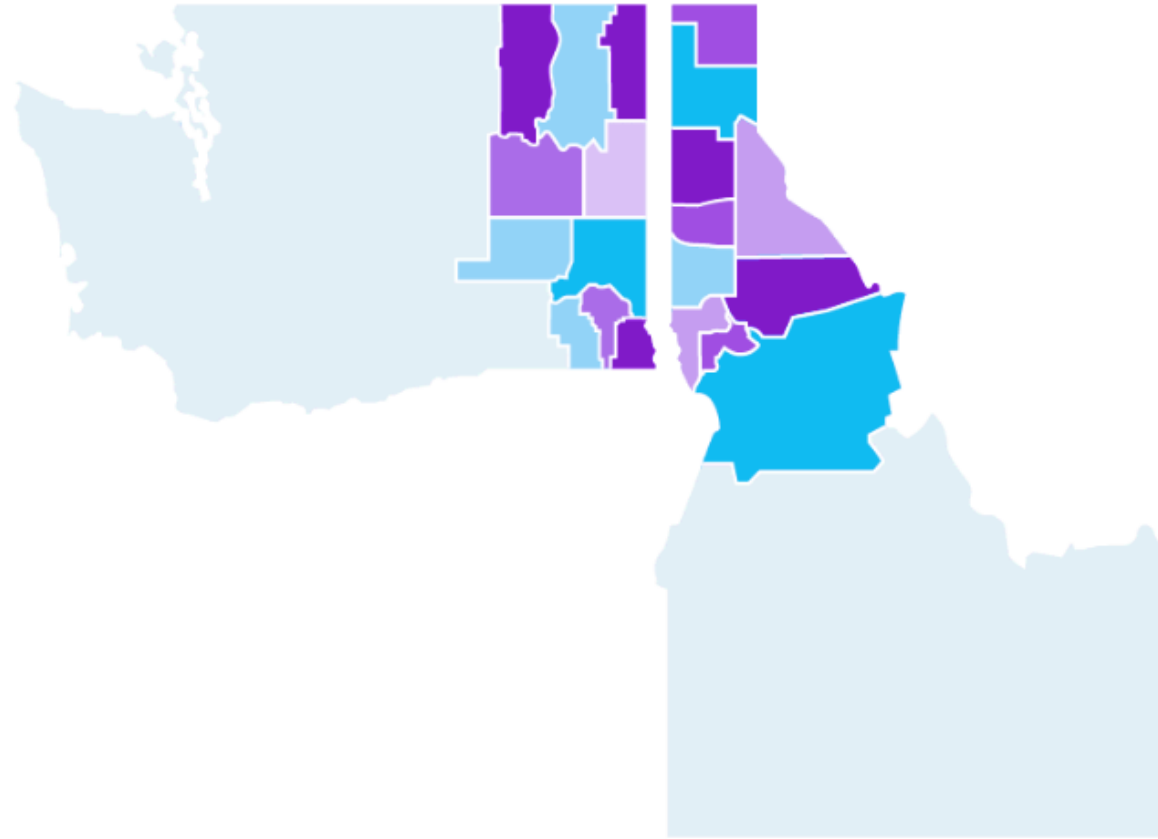

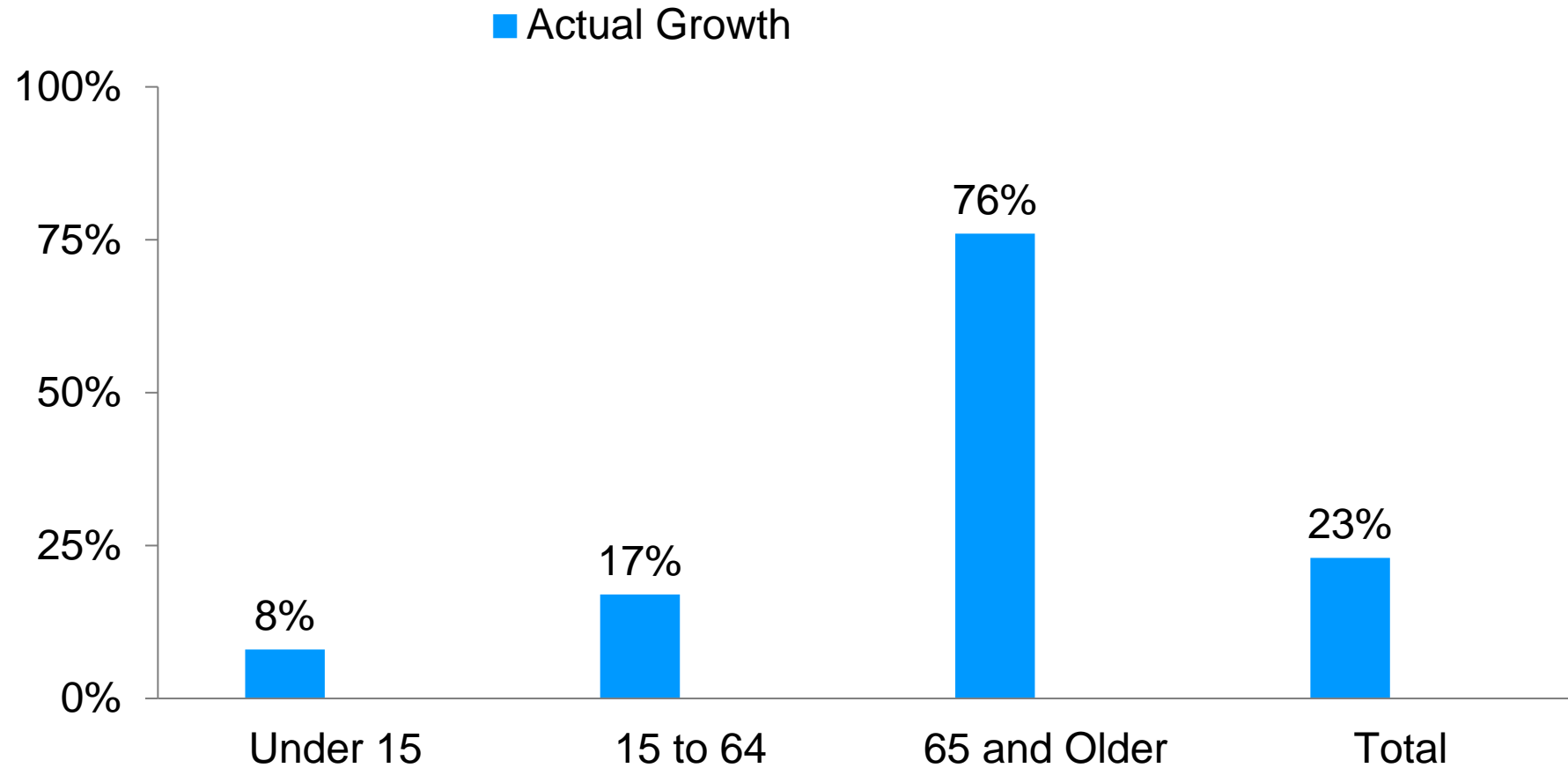
Fast Facts

From 2000-19, Total Population grew from 857,000 to 1,052,000

- Total Growth of 195,000 (23%)
 - 151,000 (77%) in Spokane & Kootenai Counties
 - 111,000 (57%) is due to migration
 - 84,000 (43%) over the age of 65

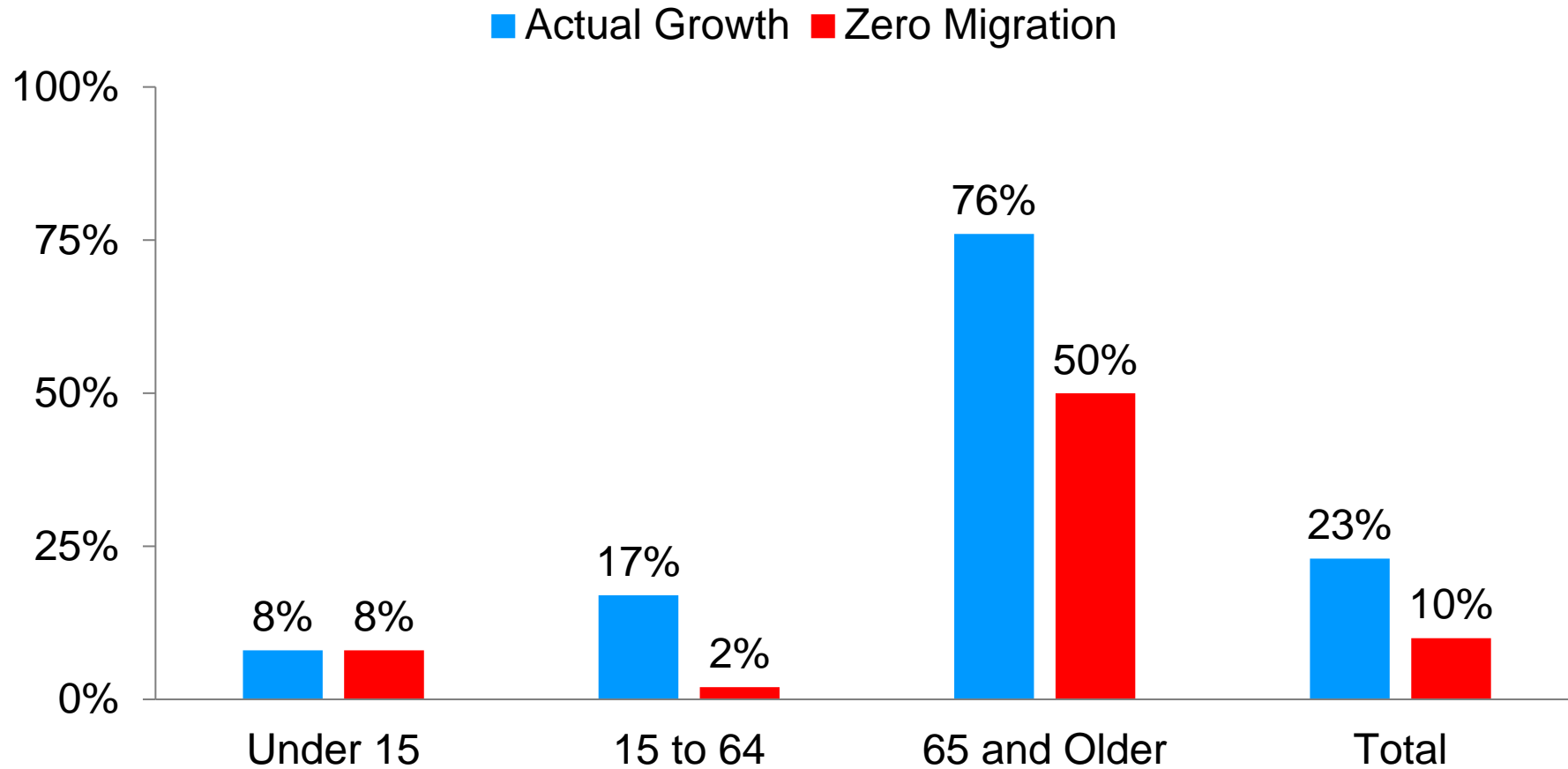
Population Growth by Age Group

Net Percentage Growth from 2001 to 2019



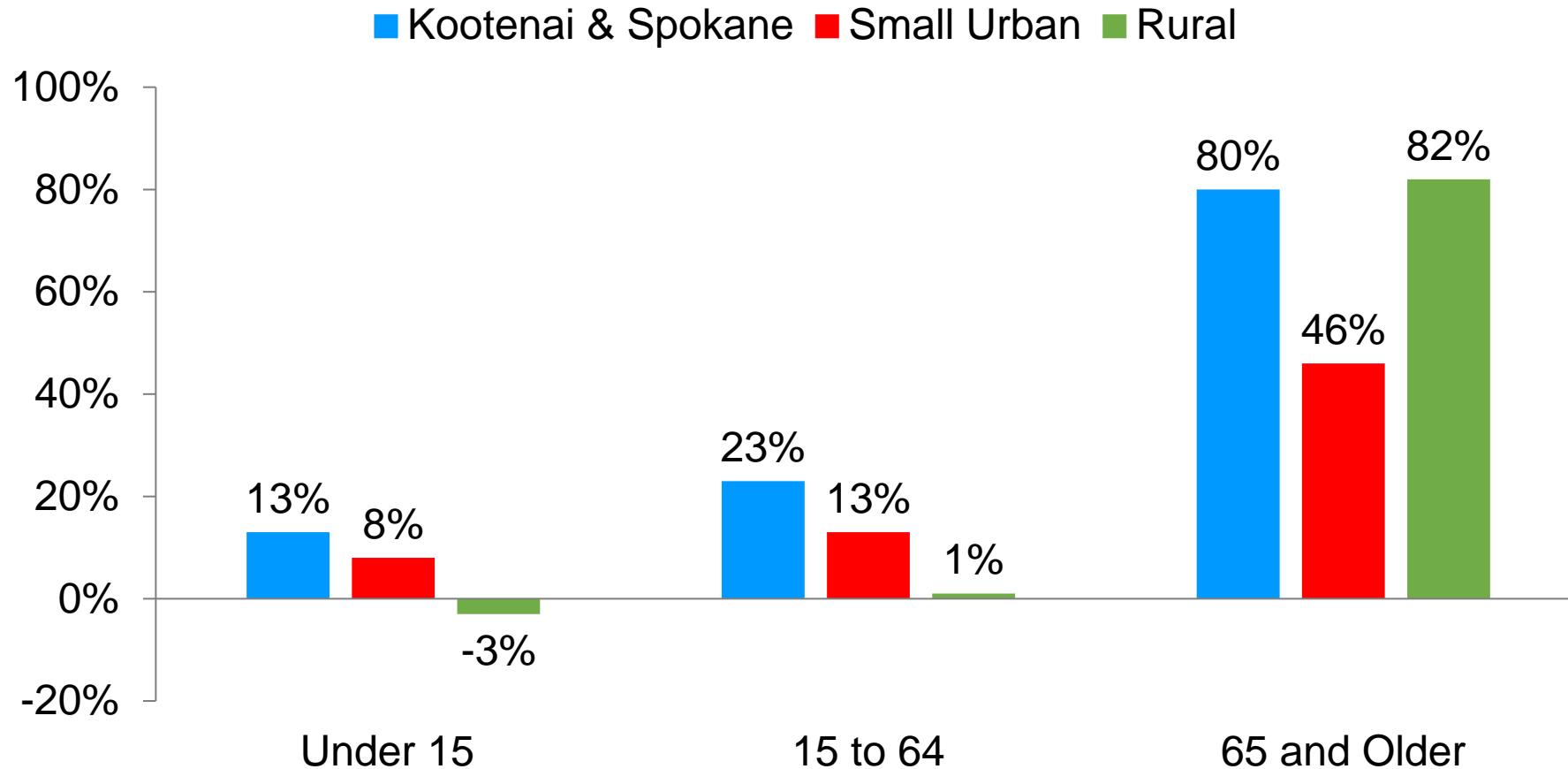

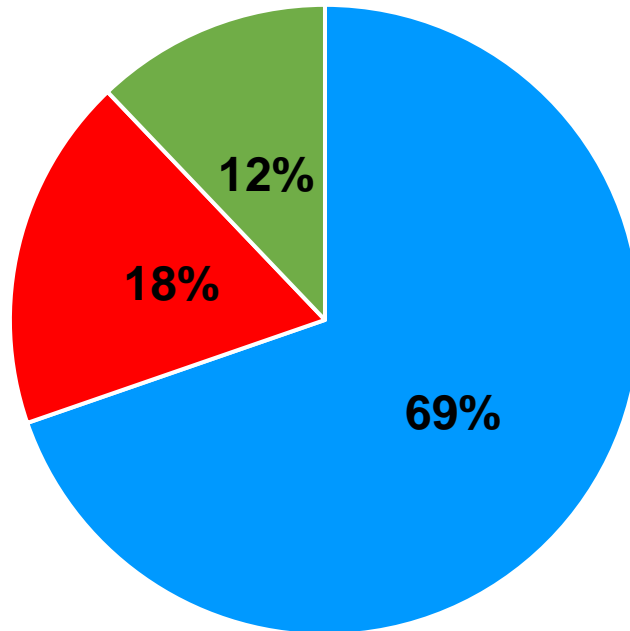

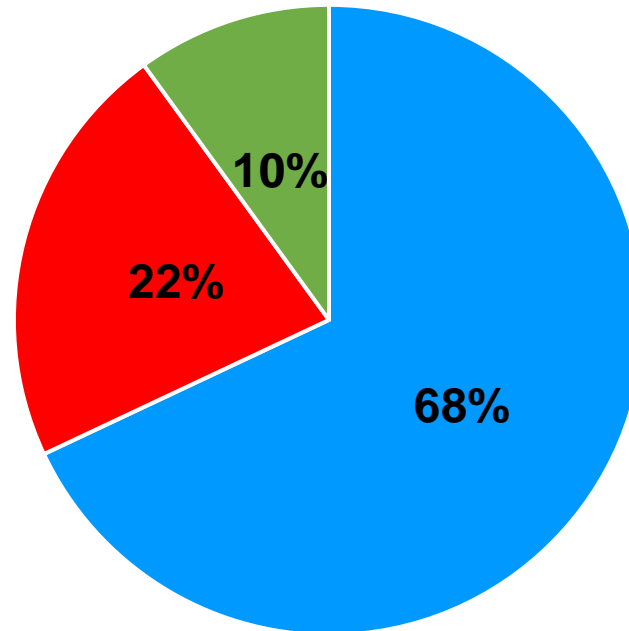
Sources of Income in 1978

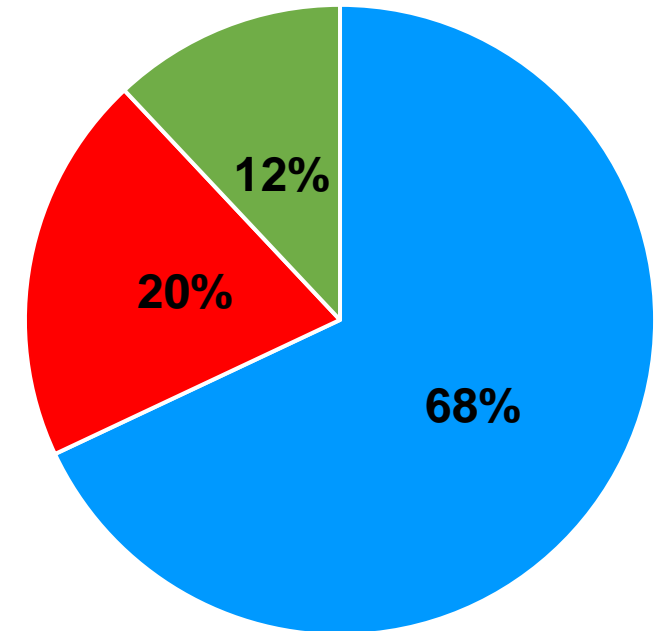

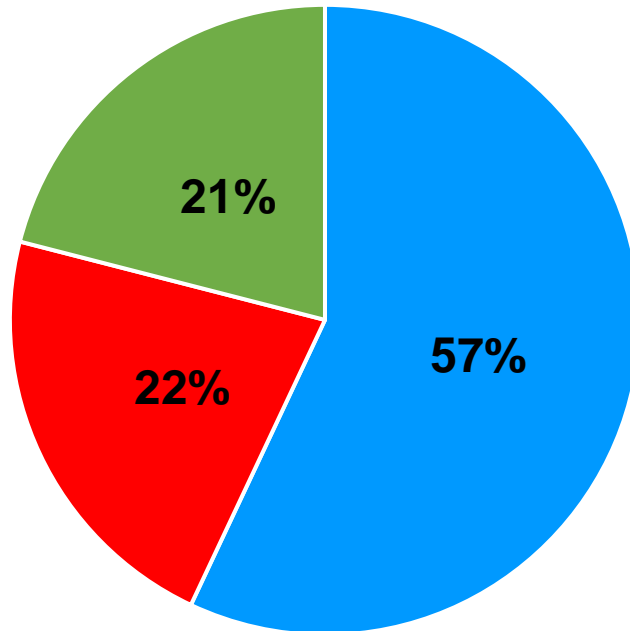

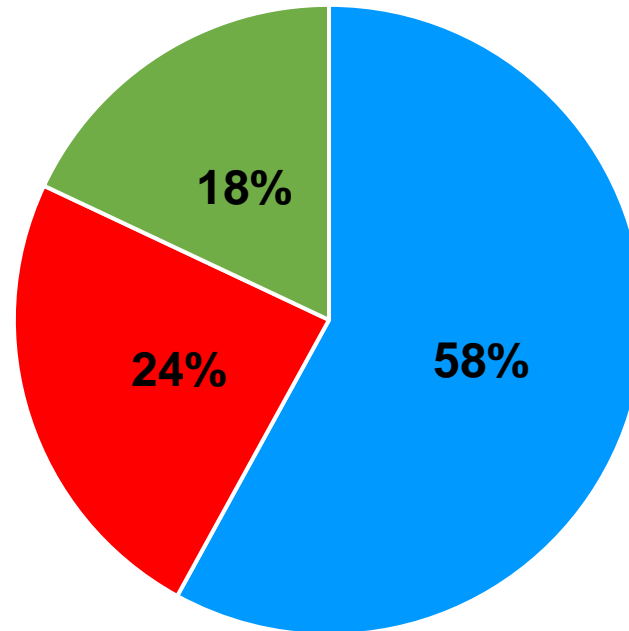
Sources of Income in 2018

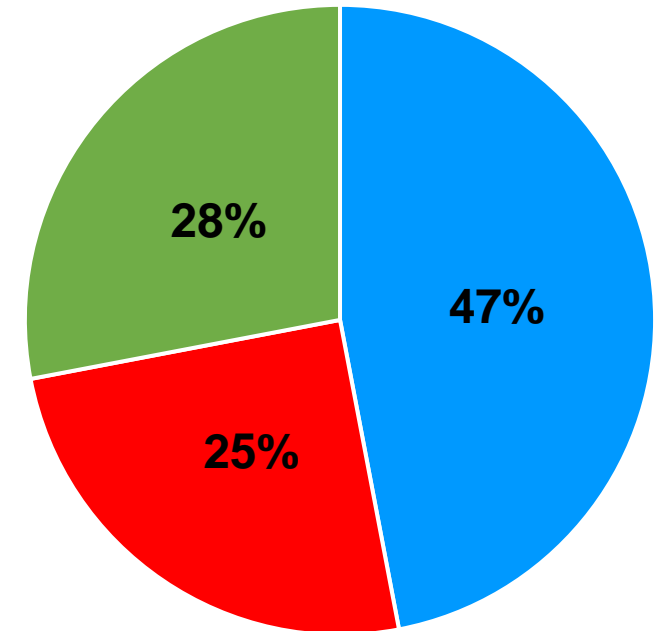

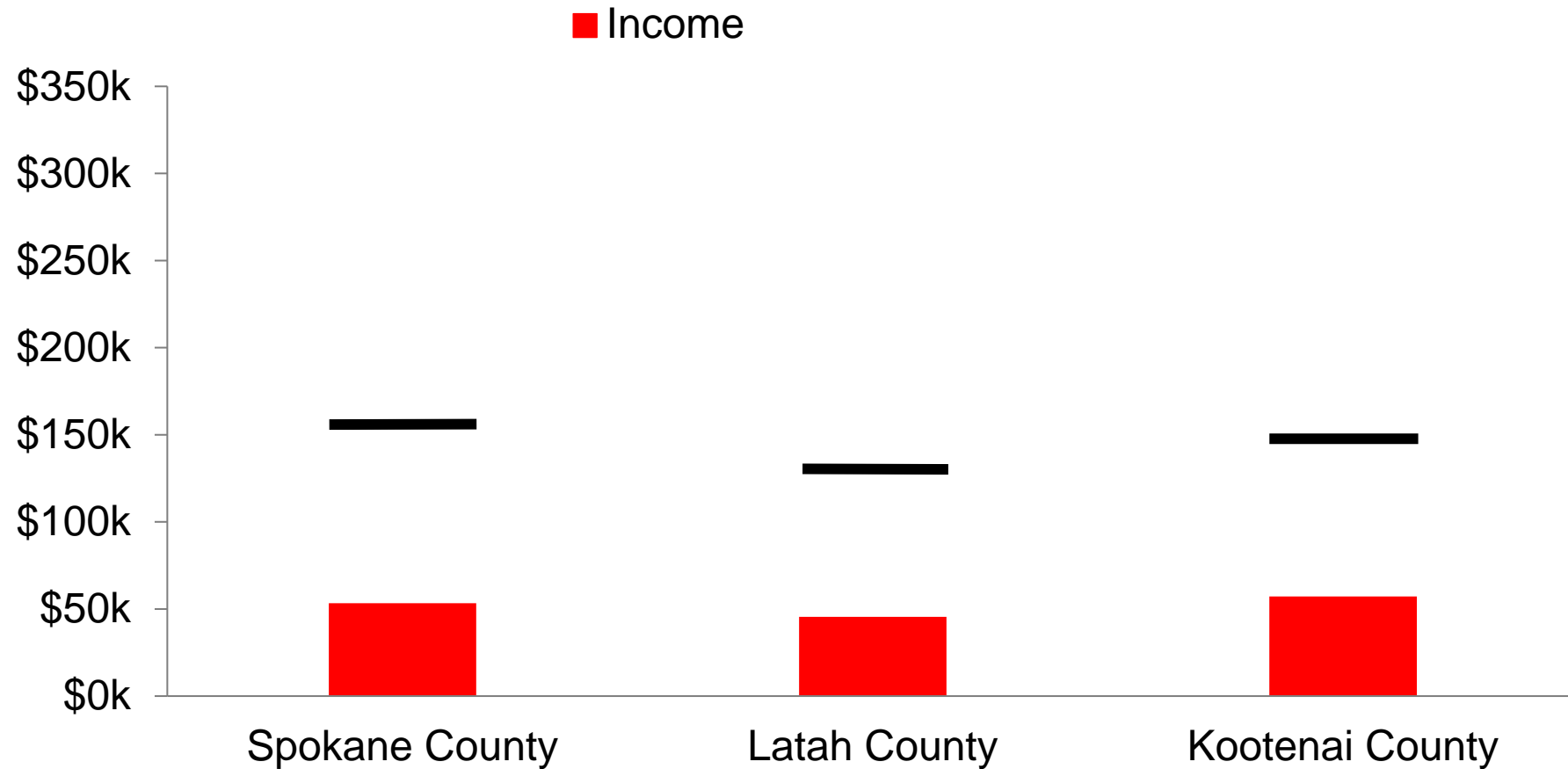

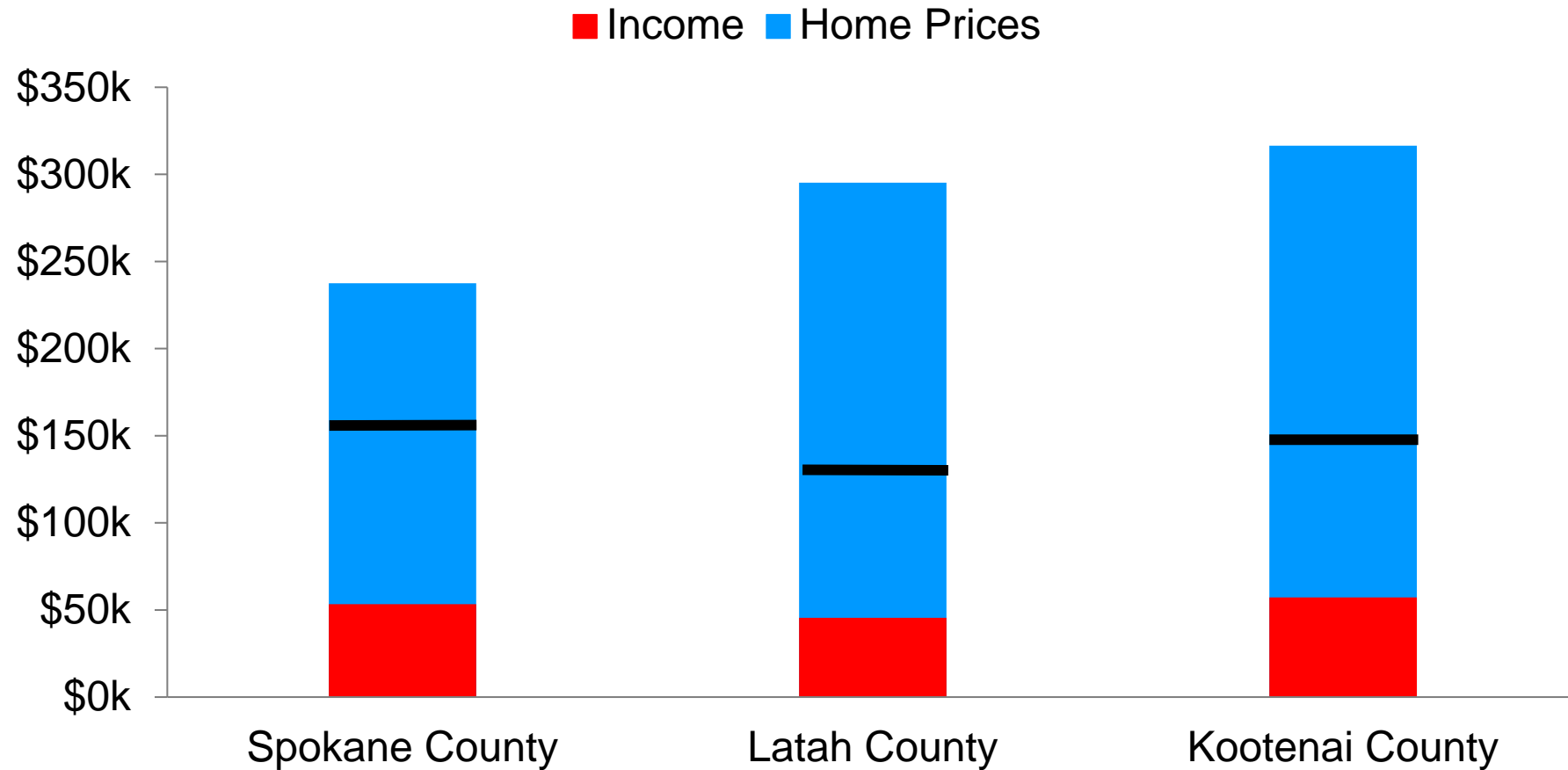

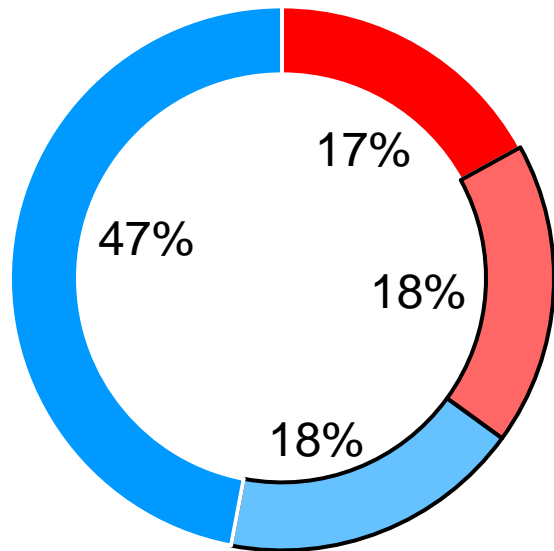

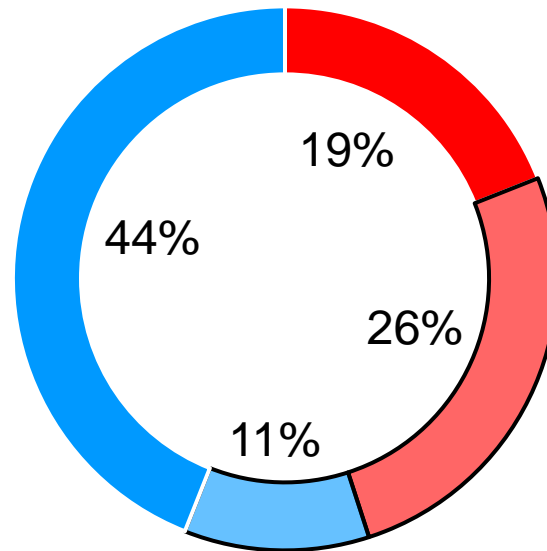
Housing Cost Burdens

Percent of Households: ■ Own ■ Rent □ Cost Burdened

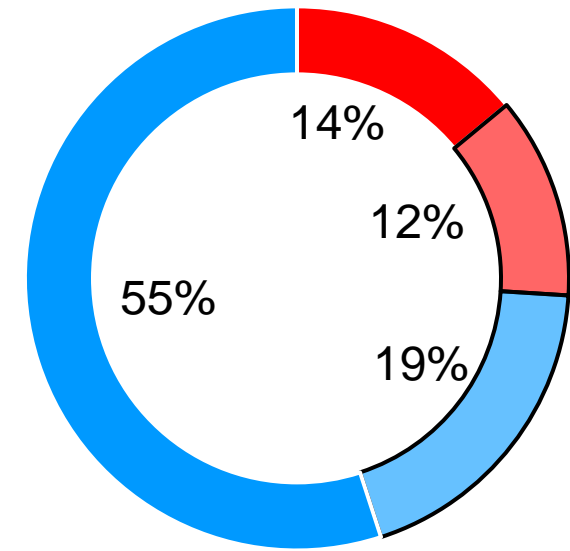

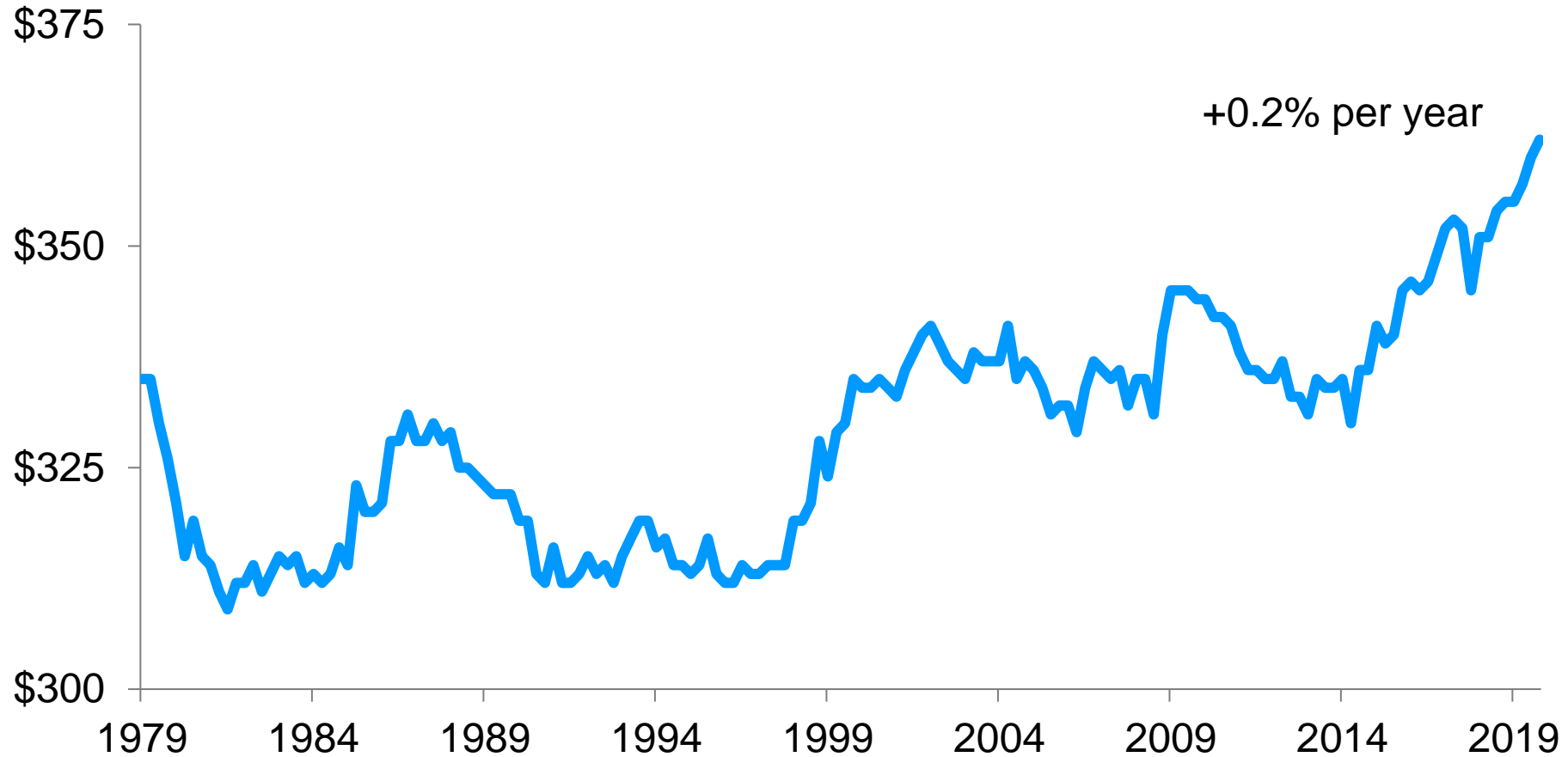
