Grant amounts are typically between \$2,000 and \$30,000 for a one-year period.

- Applications will be accepted from February 15, 2021 to April 23, 2021.
- Funding decisions will be announced in early July 2021.
- Grant awards are for a one-year period from August 1, 2021 to July 31, 2022.
